





Rice

Wholesale


Prices of both grade II local samba and grade II local nadu have decreased significantly during this week due to newly introduced control prices by the government for both local samba and nadu. Accordingly, price of grade II nadu has decreased by 4% and the price ranged between Rs.78.00-84.00/kg. Price of grade II samba has decreased by 3% and the price ranged between Rs.80.00-84.00/kg. Prices all the other local rice varieties have not changed significantly. Price range of grade I samba and grade I nadu were Rs.93.00-98.00/kg and Rs.86.00-88.00/kg respectively. The average prices of raw red and raw white were Rs.68.00/kg and Rs.78.00/kg respectively.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of grade I samba (by 12%) and grade II samba (by 21%) have decreased while the prices of grade II nadu (by 2%) and raw white (by 6%) have increased.

Retail

Prices of local samba grade I has not changed significantly and the price ranged between Rs.98.00-100.00/kg. Prices of samba II, nadu grade I and nadu grade II, have decreased by Rs.2.00/kg, Rs.1.00/kg and Rs.3.00/kg respectively. Price ranges of samba II and nadu I were Rs.90.00-95.00/kg and Rs.90.00-95.00/kg respectively. Price of raw red and raw

white have not changed significantly and their price ranges were Rs.75.00-85.00/kg and Rs.80.00-90.00/kg respectively.



Considering the all local rice varieties, the highest price of Rs.100.00/kg was reported for samba grade I from all markets while the lowest price was reported for raw red from Kadawatha market.

Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail prices of all the local rice varieties have decreased in the range of 1%-17%.

Paddy

Producer Price

With the government has announced control price for samba and nadu rice, Prices of both short grain and long grain (white) paddy varieties have further decreased in Anuradhapura, Kurunegala and Dehiattakandiya areas with introducing the control prices for samba and nadu rice by the government. Accordingly, prices of both short grain and long grain (white) paddy has decreased by Rs.1.00-3.00/kg in this areas and the average prices ranged between Rs.36.00-40.00/kg for short grain and Rs.39.00-

41.00/kg for long grain (white) paddy. The highest average price for both short grain and long grain white paddy was observed from Kurunegala area in this week too. However, a notable price decrease for both short grain and long grain white paddy also was recorded from Kurunegala area as Rs.3.00/kg. Meanwhile, price of long grain red paddy has decreased by Rs.1.00/kg in Embilipitiya area while price has remained unchanged in other major producing areas and its average price ranged between Rs.36.00-37.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of both short grain paddy (by 18%-35%) and long grain white paddy (by 1%-4%) have decreased while price of long grain red paddy has increased in the range of 4%-16%.

Dried Chilli Wholesale

Price of imported dried chillies has increased by 2% due to increased imported cost and the price ranged between Rs.265.00-285.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale price of imported dried chillies has increased by 11%.

Retail

Price of imported dried chillies has increased by Rs.3.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.300.00-400.00/kg. The highest price was reported from

Kirulapone market, while the lowest price was reported from Dematagoda market.

Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail price of imported dried chillies has increased by 8%.

Onion

Wholesale

Price of imported red onion has increased by 4% due to decreased supply of local stocks to the market and the price ranged between Rs.145.00-170.00/kg.

Price of imported big onion also has increased by 10% due to decreased supply of stocks to the market and the price ranged between Rs.85.00-100.00/kg.


Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale price of imported red onion has increased by 37% and the price of imported big onion has increased by 16%.

Retail

Price of vedalan red onions has increased by Rs.4.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.180.00-200.00/kg. The highest price for vedalan red onion was reported from Maharagama and Nugegoda markets, while the lowest price was reported from Dematagoda and Kiribathgoda markets.

Meanwhile, the price of imported big onion also has increased by Rs.5.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.100.00-120.00/kg. The highest price was reported from Maharagama and Dematagoda

markets, while the lowest price was reported from Kiribathgoda, Thotalanga and Kadawatha markets.



Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail price of imported big onion has increased by 3%.

Potato Wholesale


Price of Nuwara Eliya potato has decreased by 3% due to increased supply of stocks to the market and the price ranged between Rs.135.00-155.00/kg. Price of imported potato (Pakistan) has increased by 2% due to availability of high quality stocks in the market and the price ranged between Rs.93.00-95.00/kg. Chinese potatoes were also available in the market and the price ranged between Rs.105.00-110.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of Nuwara Eliya potato (by 8%) and imported potato (by 22%) have increased.

Retail

Price of Nuwara Eliya potato has decreased by Rs.2.00/kg and the price

ranged between Rs.180.00-240.00/kg. The highest price of Nuwara Eliya potato was reported from Nugegoda market, while the lowest price was reported from Thotalanga market. Meanwhile the price of imported potato has increased by Rs.4.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.120.00-140.00/kg. The highest price was reported from Nugegoda, and Kirulapone markets, while the lowest price was reported from Pettah, Thotalanga, Kiribathgoda and Narahenpita markets.



Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail prices of Nuwara Eliya and imported potato have increased by 10% and 12% respectively.

Pulses Wholesale

Price of red cowpea has increased by 1% due to unavailability of local stocks in the market and the price ranged between Rs.275.00-285.00/kg. Price of white cowpea also has increased by 1% due to availability of high quality stocks in the market and the price ranged between Rs.210.00-225.00/kg. Price of green gram has decreased by 1% due to availability of

low quality ‘Chinese’ stocks in the market and the price ranged between Rs.235.00-255.00/kg. Price of red dhal has not changed significantly and the average price was Rs.109.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of all types of pulses except red dhal have increased in the range of 3%-43%. While price of red dhal has decreased by 1%.

Retail

Price of white cowpea and red cowpea have increased by Rs.6.00/kg and Rs.5.00/kg respectively and their price ranges were Rs.240.00-300.00/kg and Rs.300.00-320.00/kg respectively. Price of green gram has decreased by Rs.3.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.260.00-300.00/kg. Price of red dhal has not changed significantly and the price ranged between Rs.120.00-140.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail prices of green gram and red cowpea have increased by 14% and 5% respectively. Price of red dhal has decreased by 3% and the price of white cowpea has not changed significantly.

Vegetable Wholesale

Prices of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased due to sufficient stocks received to the market.

When considering up country vegetables, prices of all the vegetable varieties except leeks have decreased due to high supply. The highest price decrease was reported for beans as 18% due to high supply from Balangoda, Bandarawela and Haputale areas. The second highest price decrease was reported for both knolkhol and cabbage as 14% due to high supply received from Welimada, Thalawakele and Nuwara Eliya areas. Next, price of raddish has decreased by 9% due to low country stocks highly received from Melsiripura and up country stocks highly received from Welimada area. Further, prices of carrot and beetroot have decreased by 7% and 4% respectively due to high supply received from Nuwara Eliya and Welimada for carrot and low country stocks received from Puttalam for beetroot. However, price of leeks has increased by 5% due to high quality stocks received from Nuwara Eliya area.

Meanwhile, price of tomato has decreased by 31% due to high supply from Sooriyawewa, Bandarawela, Welimada, Kandy and from most of the other main producing areas. Further, price of capsicum has decreased by 7% due to high supply received from Nuwara Eliya, Thalawakele and Keppetipola areas.

When considering low country vegetables, prices of all the vegetable varieties except pumpkin, cucumber, bittergourd and drumstick have decreased due to high supply received from Wadigala,

Embilipitiya and Rajanganaya areas. The highest price decrease was reported for both brinjals and long beans as 26% due to high supply received from Rajanganaya and Embilipitiya for brinjals and high supply from Puttalam, Wadigala and Beliatta for long beans. The second highest price decrease was reported for snake gourd as 25% due to high supply received from Wadigala, Embilipitiya and Balangoda areas. Next, price of luffa has decreased by 21% due to high supply received from Embilipitiya, Wadigala and Kandy areas. Further, prices of ladies fingers and ash plantain have decreased by 1% and 2% respectively due to high supply. However, price of drumstick has increased by 21% due to high quality stocks received from Mannar.

Meanwhile, price of cucumber has increased by 12% due to low supply from Kurunegala and Embilipitiya areas. Further, prices of pumpkin and bittergourd have increased by 3% and 2% respectively due to limited stocks received only from Monaragala and Buttala for pumpkin and high quality local variety of “katu karawila” stocks received from Wadigala for bittergourd.


Meanwhile, price of green chillies has increased by 16% due to high quality “MI” variety stocks received from Thambuththegama. Further, price of lime has increased by 26% due to low supply from Monaragala and Jaffna areas.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased and the highest price decrease was reported for leeks as 77%.

Retail


In line with the decreased wholesale prices, retail prices of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased.

Prices of all the upcountry vegetable varieties except leeks have decreased. The highest price decrease was reported for beans as Rs.34.00/kg. The second highest price decrease was reported for carrot as Rs.19.00/kg. Next, prices of knolkhol and raddish have decreased by Rs.12.00/kg and Rs.7.00/kg respectively. Further, prices of both, beetroot and cabbage have decreased by Rs.3.00/kg. However, price of leeks has increased by 1.00/kg due to high quality stocks available in the market.



Meanwhile, price of tomato has decreased by Rs.19.00/kg and price of capsicum has decreased by Rs.2.00/kg. Prices of all the low country vegetable varieties except

pumpkin, bittergourd and drumstick have decreased. The highest price decrease was reported for brinjals as Rs.12.00/kg.



The second highest price decrease was reported for Rs.10.00/kg for long beans. Next, prices of cucumber and ladies fingers have decreased by Rs.8.00/kg and Rs.6.00/kg respectively. Further, prices of snake gourd, luffa and ash plantain have decreased in the range of Rs.2.00-4.00/kg. However, price of pumpkin has increased by Rs.10.00/kg. Further, prices of bitter gourd and drumstick have increased by Rs.8.00/kg and Rs.3.00/kg respectively.

Meanwhile, price of green chillies and lime have increased by Rs.18/kg and Rs.16/kg respectively.

Compared to the same period of last year the current retail prices of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased with the highest price decrease was reported for Leeks as 60%.

Coconut

Wholesale

Prices of both large and small nuts have increased by 2%. Prices ranged between Rs.38.00-45.00 for large nuts and Rs.30.00-35.00 for small nuts.

Compared to the same period of last year, the current wholesale prices of both large and small nuts has decreased by 46%.

Retail

Prices of both large and small nuts have not changed significantly. Their prices ranged between Rs.50.00-65.00/nut for large nuts and Rs.35.00-45.00/nut for small nuts.

Compared to the same period of last year the current retail price of large and small nuts have decreased by 34% and 40% respectively.

Fruits

Wholesale

Prices of most of the fruit varieties have decreased due to high supply and low demand. The highest price decrease of 34% was reported for passion fruit. The second highest price decrease of 28% was reported for avocado due to low quality stocks received from Katukithula, Welimada and Nuwara Eliya areas. Further, prices of all the varieties of banana and price of papaw have decreased in the range of 1%-11% and 22% respectively due to low demand with rainy

weather condition. Furthermore, prices of both woodapple and slime apple have decreased by 17% and 6% respectively due to low quality stocks available at the market and low demand with the end of the Ramazan festival season. In addition, price decrease of 2% was reported for king coconut due to low demand with the rainy weather condition.

However, the highest price increase of 32% was reported for pineapple (small) and prices of all the other sizes of pineapple have increased in the range of 10%-17% due to sufficient stocks not available at the market. Further, prices of all the mango varieties have increased in the range of 2%-18% due to high quality stocks received from Dambulla, Anuradhapura and Puttalam areas. Price of orange has increased by 17% due to limited supply with the end of harvesting season.

Furthermore, price increase of 2% was reported for imported grapes due to high quality Australian and South African stocks available at the market.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of most of the fruits have increased and the highest price increase of 197% was noted for wood apple.

Retail

In line with the decreased wholesale prices, retail prices of most of the fruit varieties have also decreased. The highest

price decrease of Rs.24.00/kg was reported for papaw due to the low demand. The prices of woodapple has decreased by Rs.8.00/fruit due to the low quality stocks available in retail markets. Further, price of passionfruit has decreased by Rs.6.00/fruit due to the high supply. Prices of banana varieties ambul, kolikuttu and seeni have decreased in the range of Rs.2.00-4.00/kg while price of anamalu and ambun have decreased by Rs.1.00/fruit due to low demand. Prices of slime apple and king coconut have decreased by Rs.2.00/fruit. Price of avocado has decreased by Rs.1.00/fruit due to the low quality stocks available in retail markets.

However, prices of all the sizes of pineapple have increased in the range of Rs.19.00-23.00/fruit due to the limited supply. A price increase of Rs.9.00/kg was reported for imported grapes due to the high quality stocks available in retail markets. Prices of mango varieties karthakolomban and vilad have increased by Rs.7.00/fruit and Rs.1.00/fruit respectively due to the high quality stocks available in retail markets. Price of orange has increased by Rs.6.00/fruit.

Compared to the same period of last year, current retail prices of most of the fruit varieties have increased and the highest price increase of 100% was reported for pineapple (small).

Fresh Fish

Wholesale

Prices of most of the fresh fish types have increased in the range of 1%-13% due to low supply received in the off season. The highest price increase of 13% was noted for balaya due to limited supply from Galle, Beruwala and other producing areas. The second highest price increase was noted for thalapath as 9% due to limited supply from North and East areas. In addition, prices of hurulla and paraw have increased by 8% and 7% respectively, due to limited stocks in the wholesale market. Further, prices of both salaya and shrimps have increased by 6% due to low supply from Breuwala, Galle and Ambalangoda areas for salaya and the low supply from Negambo and Kalpitiya areas for shrimps.

Meanwhile, price of thora has increased by 1% due to low supply. However, the price of kelawalla has decreased by 2% due to high supply.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of most of the fresh fish types have increased in the range of 3%-28% and the highest price increase of 28% was noted for hurulla.

Retail

Retail prices of all fresh fish types except kelawalla have increased in line with the increased wholesale prices. The highest price increase of Rs.48.00/kg was reported

for balaya and shrimps and their price ranged between Rs.720.00-860.00/kg in balaya and Rs.1,100.00-1,300.00/kg in shrimps. The second highest price increase was reported for mora as Rs.40.00/kg and the price range was Rs.900.00-1,080.00/kg. In addition, prices of salaya and thalapath also have increased by Rs.31.00/kg and Rs.22.00/kg respectively. and their price ranges were Rs.320.00-400.00/kg and Rs.1,200.00-1,400.00/kg respectively. Further, prices of hurulla, paraw and thora have increased by Rs.16.00/kg, Rs.8.00/kg and Rs.2.00/kg respectively and their price ranges were Rs.500.00-680.00/kg in hurulla, Rs.1,000.00-1,400.00/kg in paraw and Rs.1,520.00-2,300.000/kg in thora. Meanwhile, prices of kelawalla has decreased by Rs.9.00/kg and the price range was Rs.950.00-1,300.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, current retail prices of all the fresh fish types except shrimps and thora have increased in the range of 10%-27% and the highest price increase of 27% was reported for balaya.


Dried Fish

Wholesale

Prices of most of the local and imported dried fish types have decreased in the range of 1%-6%. The highest price decrease of 6% was noted for local salaya due to availability of low quality stocks in wholesale market. The second highest price decrease was noted for imported

maduwa as 4% due to availability of low quality stocks, which were imported from china. In addition, price of both imported sprats and imported mora have decreased by 3% due to high supply from Iran for imported sprats and low quality stocks received from Dubai and Vietnam for imported mora. Further, price of imported and local kattawa and local anguluwa have decreased by 2%, 1% and 1% respectively.

Meanwhile, the price of local maduwa has increased by 5% due to high quality stocks received from Jaffna area. Further, price of local balaya and local sprats have increased by 4% and 1% respectively, due to low supply. Prices of local mora and imported anguluwa have not changed significantly during this week.



Compared to the same period of last year, the current wholesale prices of most of the dried fish types have increased in the range of 3%-18% and the highest price increase of 18% was noted for local salaya.

Retail

Prices of most of the dried fish types have decreased in line with the decreased

wholesale prices. The highest price decrease was reported for salaya as Rs.19.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.500.00-700.00/kg. The second highest price decrease was reported for anguluwa as Rs.11.00/kg and the price range was Rs.960.00-1,400.00/kg. In addition, prices of mora, kattawa and imported sprats have decreased by Rs.10.00/kg, Rs.9.00/kg and Rs.9.00/kg respectively and their price ranges were Rs.980.00-1,400.00/kg in mora, Rs.1,200.00-1,600.00/kg in kattawa and Rs.500.00-800.00/kg in imported sprats. Meanwhile, prices of thora has increased by Rs.33.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.1,500.00-2,000.00/kg. Further, price of maduwa, balaya and local sprats have increased by Rs.30.00/kg, Rs.23.00/kg and Rs.20.00/kg respectively and their price ranges were Rs.800.00-1,000.00/kg in maduwa, Rs.700.00-1,000.00/kg in balaya and Rs.1,100.00-1,600.00/kg in local sprats.

Compared to the same period of last year, current retail prices of all dried fish types except imported sprats and salaya have increased in the range of 3%-14% and the highest price increase was reported for anguluwa and kattawa.

Eggs

Wholesale

Prices of both brown and white eggs have not changed significantly during this week. The average price of a brown egg was Rs.15.50 and the average price of a white egg was Rs.14.50.

Compared to the same period of last year, current wholesale prices of both brown and white eggs have increased by 1%.

Retail

Prices of both brown and white eggs have not changed significantly during this week. Price range of a brown egg was Rs.16.00-18.00 and the lowest price was reported from Pettah, Kirulapone, Nugegoda and Kadawatha markets while the highest price was reported from Dematagoda market. Price range of a white egg was Rs.15.00-17.00 and the lowest price was reported from Pettah, Kirulapone, Thotalanga and Kadawatha markets while the highest price was reported from Dematagoda market.

Compared to the same period of last year, current retail prices of brown and white eggs have increased by 3% and 2% respectively.

Meat

Retail

Prices of meat types have decreased. The highest price decrease of Rs.5.00/kg was reported for curry chicken and the price ranged between Rs.500.00-600.00/kg. In addition, price of beef has decreased by Rs.2.00/kg and the price range was Rs.950.00-1,000.00/kg. Further, price of mutton has increased by Rs.4.00/kg and the price range was Rs.1,800.00-2,100.00/kg.

Meanwhile, price of pork and broiler chicken have not changed significantly

and their price ranges were Rs.700.00-840.00/kg in pork and Rs.480.00-630.00/kg in broiler chicken.

Compared to the same period of last year, current retail prices of other meat types except broiler chicken and curry chicken have increased in the range of 2%-36% and the highest price increase was noted for pork.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Food Commodities Bulletin is a weekly publication containing information relating to wholesale and retail prices of selected food commodities in nine selected markets in and around Colombo and main markets in the major producing areas.

The information is analyzed and presented as prevailing prices, price ranges, averages and comparison of weekly prices. The changes in prices reported are always in relation to price prevailed during the previous week unless otherwise stated.

The frequency of collection of wholesale price information is twice a week (i.e. Tuesday and Friday) while with retail prices, it is thrice a week (i.e. Friday, Monday and Tuesday).



