RETAIL MARKET AT A GLANCE

Summary

Rice



Retail prices of all types of local and imported rice varieties have not changed significantly. Except for samba grade I, samba grade II, and Keeri Samba, retail prices of all types of local rice varieties have decreased marginally by Rs.1.00-6.00/kg. The highest price decrease was reported for raw red and the price ranged as Rs.170.00-210.00/kg. Prices of all types of imported rice varieties have also decreased marginally by Rs.1 /kg. However, compared to the same period of last year, prices of local and imported rice varieties have increased by 6%-33% and 40% -59% respectively. Except for long grain red paddy, the average farm gate paddy price has increased slightly for most of the major paddy varieties.


Other Field Crops



Retail prices of most of the other field crops have decreased except for imported potato. The price of imported dried chilies has dropped by Rs.53.00/kg and the price ranged Rs.1300.00-1800.00/kg. Price of imported red onion has increased by Rs.97.00/kg and the price ranged Rs.400.00-600.00/kg. Price of imported big onion has decreased slightly (7%) and price ranged Rs.140.00-180.00/kg. Price of imported potato has increased by Rs.20.00/kg and the price ranged Rs.150.00-240.00/kg. However, compared to the same period of last year, prices of imported dried chilli, Nuwara Eliya potato and imported potato have increased by 49%, 15% and 14% respectively.





Vegetables



Prices for the majority of vegetable varieties have fallen due to increased market supply in the early stages of the Maha vegetable harvesting season. The most significant price decrease was reported for capsicum at Rs.100.00/kg following the same trend last week, followed by tomato at Rs.49.00/kg. However, the highest price increase of Rs.26.00/kg was reported for beans(Green). Prices for vegetables are expected to decrease further in the upcoming week.

Rice

Wholesale

Prices of both grade II nadu and raw red have decreased by 2% due to increased supply and their price ranges were Rs.170.00-185.00/kg and Rs.157.00-185.00/kg respectively. Prices of all other local rice varieties have not changed significantly and price ranges of grade II samba and raw white were Rs.200.00-210.00/kg and Rs.160.00-190.00/kg respectively. Average prices of grade I samba, grade I nadu and keeri samba were Rs.211.00/kg, Rs.187.00/kg and Rs.219.00/kg respectively.


Prices of all types of imported rice varieties have decreased due to increased supply of local rice varieties. Prices of both ponni samba and imported raw white have decreased by 2% and their price ranges were Rs.188.00-195.00/kg and Rs.153.00-162.00/kg respectively. Price of imported nadu has decreased by 1% and the average price was Rs.164.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all types of local rice varieties have increased in the range of 6%-31% and prices of ponni samba, imported nadu and imported raw white have increased by 57%, 45% and 43% respectively.

Retail

Price of samba grade I, samba grade II and keeri samba have increased by Rs.1.00/kg, Rs.1.00/kg and Rs.4.00/kg respectively. Their price ranges were Rs.220.00-230.00/kg, Rs.210.00-225.00/kg and Rs.240.00-260.00/kg respectively. Price of nadu I, nadu II, raw red and raw white have decreased by Rs.2.00/kg, Rs.5.00/kg Rs.6.00/kg and Rs.1.00/kg respectively. Their price ranges were Rs.210.00-220.00/kg, Rs.190.00-210.00/kg, Rs.170.00-210.00/kg and Rs.180.00-210.00/kg respectively.

Price of both imported samba and imported raw white have decreased by Rs.1.00/kg and price ranged between Rs.200.00-220.00/kg and Rs.160.00-190.00/kg. Imported nadu have not changed significantly. And the price range was Rs.180.00-200.00/kg.



Compared to the same period of last year, all prices of local rice varieties have increased in the 7%-33% range. All

imported rice varieties have increased in the range of 40-59%.

Paddy

The average farm gate prices of short grain (samba) paddy, keeri samba paddy and long grain (white) paddy have slightly increased in most of the producing areas. Long grain (red) paddy prices slightly decreased in Mattara, Hambantota and Embilipitiya areas.

The average farm gate prices of short grain paddy have increased by Rs.1.00-11.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.95.00-112.00/kg. However, in Polonnaruwa average farm gate price of short grain paddy remained unchanged at Rs.103.00/kg. The highest price increase for short grain paddy was reported in Ampara as 11%. Next, the average prices of keeri samba paddy also has increased except in Polonnaruwa by Rs.2.00-3.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.103.00-116.00/kg. Also, average prices of long grain (white) paddy has increased except in Dehiattakandiya by Rs.1.00-4.00/kg. In Dehiattakandiya district long grain (white) paddy prices decreased by Rs.1.00/kg. However, a price decrease of Rs.1.00-4.00/kg was reported for long grain (red) paddy in major producing areas and the price ranged Rs.85.00-95.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, the average farm gate paddy prices of short

grain (8-39%), long grain (white) (5-39%) and keeri samba (4-18%) paddy varieties have increased while the price of long grain (white) (5-39%) and keeri samba (4-18%) paddy varieties have increased. Price of long grain (red) paddy has decreased by 2-4% except in Hambantota. In Hambantota long grain (red) prices increased by 4%.

Dried Chilies

Wholesale

Price of imported dried chilies has significantly not changed and the price ranged between Rs.1100.00-1300.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale price of imported dried chilies prices has increased by 29%.

Retail

Price of imported dried chilies has decreased by Rs.53.00/kg and price range was Rs.1300.00-1800.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, imported dried chilies has increased by 50%.

Onion

Wholesale


Price of imported red onion has decreased by 7% due to increased supply of Indian stocks to the market and the price ranged Rs.250.00-330.00/kg.

Price of imported big onion has increased by 7% due to availability of high quality Indian stocks in the market and the price ranged between Rs.110.00-130.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale price of imported red onion and imported big onion have decreased by 25% and 2% respectively.

Retail

Price of imported red onion and big onion have decreased by Rs.97.00/kg and Rs.7.00/kg respectively. Price ranged between Rs.400.00-600.00/kg and Rs.140.00-180.00/kg respectively. Local red onions and local big onions were not available in the market during this week.



Compared to the same period of last year, imported red onion and big onion prices have decreased by 10% and 8% respectively.

Potato


Wholesale

Price of imported potato has increased by 48% due to limited supply and the price ranged between Rs.140.00-190.00/kg. Price of Nuwara Eliya potato has decreased by 2% due to increased supply and the price ranged between Rs.250.00-290.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of imported potatoes and Nuwara Eliya potatoes have increased by 58% and 13% respectively.

Retail

Price of Nuwara Eliya potato have decreased by Rs.1.00/kg and price ranged between Rs.300.00-480.00/kg. Price of imported potato have increased by Rs.20.00/kg and price ranged between Rs.150.00-240.00/kg.



Compared to the same period of last year, Nuwara Eliya and imported potato have increased by 15% and 14% respectively.

Pulses

Wholesale

Prices of both red and white cowpea decreased by 3% due to increased supply of local stocks to the market and both prices ranged between Rs.950.00-1050.00/kg. Price of green gram increased by 6% due to decreased supply of local stocks to the market and the price ranged between Rs.1350.00-1475.00/kg. Price of red dhal have not changed significantly and price ranged between Rs.335.00-340.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all pulse varieties increased in the range of 12%-175%.

Retail

Price of green gram has increased by Rs.14.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.1400.00-1600.00/kg. Price of all other pulse varieties decreased by Rs.2.00-35.00/kg. Price ranges of white cowpea and red cowpea were Rs.1200.00-1600.00/kg and the red dhal price range was Rs.350.00-380.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all pulse varieties have increased in the 15%-138% range.

Vegetable

Wholesale

Prices of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased with the commencement of maha vegetable harvesting season.

Considering up country vegetables, price of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased. The highest price decrease was reported for leeks as 22% due to increased market supply from Nuwara Eliya and Thalawakele areas. Next, a price decrease of 10% was reported for beetroot by due to increased market supply from Puttlam area. Price of knolkhol has decreased by 7% due to low quality stocks received from Kandy and Hanguranketha areas. However, prices of cabbage and raddish have increased by 21% and 6% respectively due to limiting the previous high supply from most of the up country and low country producing area.

Meanwhile, price of tomato has decreased by 29% due to increased market supply from Kandy and Balangoda areas. Further, price of capsicum has decreased by 9% due to increased market supply from Nuwara Eliya. Considering low country vegetables, prices of most of the vegetable varieties have decreased. The highest price decrease was reported for brinjals as 15% due to

increased market supply from Embilipitiya and most of the main producing areas. The price of cucumber has decreased by 6% due to increased market supply from Embilipitiya area. Further, price of pumpkin, bitter gourd, snake gourd and ash plantain has decreased in the range of 1%-4%. However, prices of long beans, ladies fingers and luffa have increased in the range of 9%-10% due to limited stocks received from main producing areas.


Meanwhile, price of green chilies has decreased by 20% due to increased market supply from Puttalam area. However, price of lime has increased by 4%.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of a considerable number of vegetable varieties have decreased with the highest price decrease of 74% reported for carrot.


Retail

In line with the decreased wholesale market prices, retail prices of most of the vegetable varieties have also decreased.

Considering up- country vegetables the highest price decrease was reported for leeks as Rs.40.00/kg, followed by beet root as Rs.32.00/kg. However, price of beans has increased by Rs.26.00/kg.



Prices of tomato and capsicum have decreased by Rs.49.00/kg and Rs.100.00/kg respectively.



Considering low country vegetables, the highest price decrease was reported for bitter gourd as Rs.18.00/kg, followed by luffa as Rs.11.00/kg. However, prices of ladies fingers and snake gourd have increased by Rs.19.00/kg and Rs.16.00/kg respectively.

Further, price of green chilies has decreased by Rs.20.00/kg and price of lime has increased by Rs.9.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of considerable of vegetable varieties have decreased and may record a

price surge. The highest was reported for ash plantain as 108%.

Coconut

Wholesales

Prices of both large and small nuts have not changed significantly. Their prices ranged between Rs.98.00-100.00/nut for large nuts and Rs.88.00-92.00/nut for small nuts. Compared to the same period of last year prices of both large and small nuts have increased by 34% and 36% respectively.

Retail

Prices of both large and small nuts have decreased by Rs.1.00/nut. Price ranges were Rs.110.00-130.00 for a large nut and Rs.90.00-100.00 for a small nut.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of large and small nuts have increased by 29% and 26% respectively.

Fruits

Wholesale

Prices of most of fruit varieties increased with limited supply. The highest price increase was reported for mango-betti as 90% with limited supply due to off-season. Price of mango- karthakolomban also increased by 31%. Price of orange increased by 55% due to availability of limited stocks.

Further, price of papaw increased by 15% as availability of limited stocks and high demand. Price of king coconut increased by 5%. The price of ambun and anamalu banana increased by 11% and 8% respectively due to limited stocks. In addition, price of all sizes of pineapple increased in the range of 1%-2% as quality stocks were available. A slight price increase of 1% reported for passion fruit.

However, a price decrease was reported for ambul (14%), kolikuttu (6%) and seeni (4%) banana with availability of ripe fruits. Price of slime apple (3%) and wood apple (1%) decreased with low demand. Further, a slight price decrease was reported for avocado (1%) and imported grapes.

Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale prices of most of the fruit varieties have increased with the highest price increase of 164% reported for banana-ambul.

Retail

Retail prices of most of fruits have increased in line with the increased wholesale prices. The highest price increase of Rs.85.00/fruit was reported for mango-karthakolomban due to limited supply. Prices of all sizes of pineapple have increased in the range of Rs.1.00-32.00/fruit due to availability of quality

stocks. Further, the price of slime apple has increased by Rs.13.00/fruit. A price increase of Rs.6.00/kg was reported for papaw due to limited stocks. Prices of both orange and king coconut have increased by Rs.4.00/fruit.

Meanwhile, the price of avocado has decreased by Rs.33.00/fruit due to low demand. Prices of banana- ambul, kolikuttu and seeni have decreased in the range of Rs.1.00-11.00/kg due to low quality stocks. The price of wood apple and imported grapes have decreased by Rs.4.00/fruit and Rs.3.00/kg respectively.

Compared to the same period of last year, retail prices of all fruits have increased and the highest price increase of 124% was reported for banana- ambul.

noted for thora due to low supply from Northern areas and the price ranged between Rs.2000.00-2800.00/kg. Also, wholesale prices of hurulla and balaya have increased by 1% and 5% respectively.

However, a price decrease of 21% was noted for salaya due to high supply from Trincomalee and Mannar areas and the price ranged between Rs.280.00-450.00/kg. Likewise, a price decrease of 5% was noted for kelawalla due to high supply from Beruwala and Galle areas and the price ranged between Rs.1100.00-1300.00/kg. In addition, price of paraw has decreased by 4%.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of fresh fish types have increased in the range of 34%-72% and the highest price increase was noted for salaya.

Fresh Fish


Wholesale

Prices of most of the fresh fish types have increased due to limited supply compared to demand. The highest price increase of 21% was noted for mora due to low supply from Northern areas and the price ranged between Rs.950.00-1300.00/kg. A price increase of 13% was noted thalapath due to low supply from Negombo and Walachchenai areas and the price ranged between Rs.1400.00-2300.00/kg. Likewise, a price increase of 12% was

Retail

Prices of most types of fresh fish have further increased in line with increased wholesale prices with limited supply. The highest price increase was reported for thora and kelawalla in the range of Rs.90.00-93.00/kg. Prices of balaya and paraw have also increased in the range of Rs.42.00-43.00/kg. Further, price of thalapath has increased by Rs.21.00/kg. However, prices of shrimps and salaya have decreased by Rs.124.00/kg and

Rs.56.00/kg respectively due to low demand.



Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all types of fresh fish have increased in the range of 39%-88% and the highest price increase was reported for salaya.

local maduwa and local sprats due to high supply from Negombo and Trincomalee areas and their prices ranged between Rs.1150.00-1280.00/kg and Rs.1200.00-1340.00/kg respectively. In addition, price of local mora has decrease by 2%.

However, a price increase of 1% was noted for imported kattawa due to low supply from Oman and Indonesia and the price ranged between Rs.1650.00-1800.00/kg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all dried fish types have increased in the range of 18%-65% and the highest price increase was reported for imported kattawa.

Dried Fish

Wholesale

Due to increase of local dried fish supply, prices of most of the local and imported dried fish types have decreased. The highest price decrease of 6% was noted for local salaya due to high supply from Mannar and Chilaw areas and the price ranged between Rs.720.00-850.00/kg. A price decrease of 5% was noted for local balaya due to high supply from Negombo and Beruwala areas and the price ranged between Rs.800.00-880.00/kg. Likewise, the prices decrease of 4% were noted for

Retail

In line with decreased wholesale prices, retail prices of all types of dried fish except local sprats have decreased with low demand. The highest price decrease was reported for mora by Rs.118.00/kg followed as Rs.110.00/kg for anguluwa. The remaining items have decreased in the range of Rs.10.00-63.00/kg. Price of local sprat has increased by Rs.22.00/kg due to insufficient stocks in the market.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all types of dried fish have increased in the range of 32%-78% and the

highest price increase was reported for salaya.

Eggs

Wholesale

The prices of brown egg and white egg have increased by 1% and brown egg average price was Rs.46.00/egg and a white egg price ranged between Rs.43.00-44.00/egg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of both brown and white eggs have increased by 152% and 169% respectively.

Retail

Prices of both brown and white eggs have not changed significantly. Average price of a brown egg was Rs.46.00 and Rs.44.00 for a white egg.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of brown and white eggs have increased by 140% and 151% respectively.

Meat

Retail

Price of beef has increased by Rs.85.00/kg due to insufficient supply with low meat production. Price of skin-less curry chicken has also increased by Rs.13.00/kg. Meanwhile, prices of pork and skin-less broiler chicken have decreased by

Rs.16.00/kg and Rs.8.00/kg with low demand.

Compared to the same period of last year, prices of all types of meat have increased in the range of 47%-98% and the highest price increase was reported for pork.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Food Commodities Bulletin is a weekly publication containing information relating to wholesale and retail prices of selected food commodities in nine selected markets in and around Colombo and main markets in the major producing areas.

The information is analyzed and presented as prevailing prices, price ranges, averages, and a comparison of weekly prices. The changes in prices reported are always with price prevailed during the previous week unless otherwise stated.

The frequency of collection of wholesale price information is twice a week (i.e. Tuesday and Friday) while with retail prices, it is thrice a week (i.e. Friday, Monday, and Tuesday).



