### Highlights

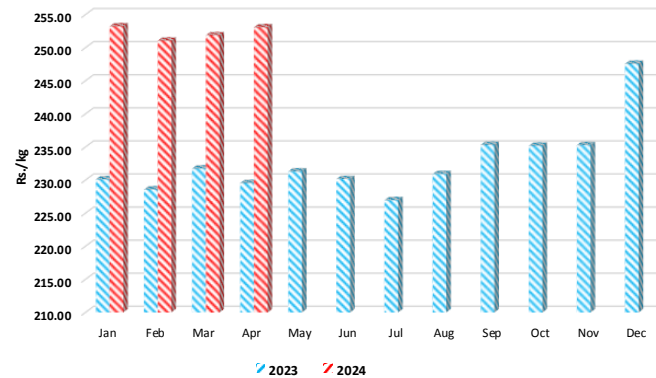
#### Paddy/Rice

- An upward trend in paddy prices for short grain, long grain white, and keeri samba observed in April 2024 due to limited supply.
- Keeri Samba was scarcely available at the retail level, with prices ranging from Rs.350.00 to Rs.380.00/kg, exceeding the maximum retail price (MRP).

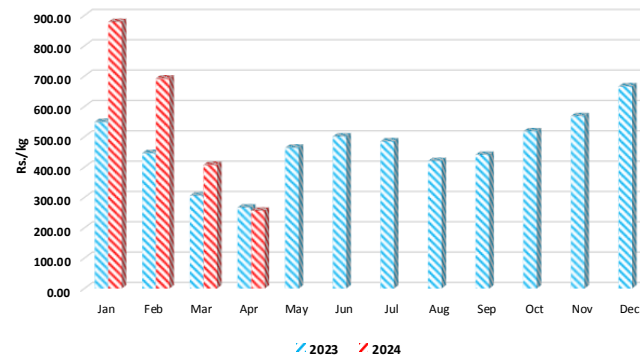
#### Vegetables

- Retail prices for vegetables dropped by 10%–52%, with the highest price decrease reported for tomatoes at Rs.226.00/kg.
- Drumsticks had the highest average price at Rs.553.00/kg, while radish had the lowest at Rs.182.00/kg.
- Lime prices increased by Rs.672/kg.

## 1. Paddy/Rice

### Producer Prices

Harvesting of Maha 2023/24 was completed in all major producing areas by previous month. An upward trend in paddy prices for short grain, long grain white, and keeri samba was observed due to limited supply during April 2024. As a result, producer prices for all paddy varieties have increased across almost all major producing areas compared to the previous month. Producer prices for short grain paddy rose by 4-13% in all the major producing areas reporting the highest price from Polonnaruwa.

The average producer prices for long grain white paddy ranged between Rs.110.00 and Rs.120.00/kg in major producing areas, marking a 2-12% increase compared to the previous month. The most significant price increase for long grain white was noted in Anuradhapura, Polonnaruwa and Kalawewa. Meanwhile, producer prices for long grain red paddy, ranging from Rs.88.00 to Rs.110.00/kg in Hambantota, Matara, and Embilipitiya, increased by 8-13% due to decreased supply. Additionally, the producer price of keeri samba ranged from Rs.140.00 to Rs.158.00/kg, showing a 2-11% increase in all major producing areas.

Compared to the same period last year, producer prices for all paddy varieties have increased across almost all price collection areas, with keeri samba experiencing the highest price rise, ranging from 20-36%.

## Rice Prices Demand/Supply Situation

### Wholesale Prices

Supply of local rice varieties tend to decline in off season. The demand for rice also increased during the festive season. As a result, wholesale prices for almost all the rice varieties have increased by less than 3% recording the highest price increase for raw white. However, the supply of keeri samba rice slightly increased, leading to a 1% price decrease. The price of Keeri Samba ranged between Rs.310.00 and Rs.325.00/kg. Wholesale prices for Samba Grade I ranged from Rs.235.00 to Rs.240.00/kg. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices for all rice varieties have increased by 10-28%, with Keeri Samba experiencing the highest rise of Rs.69.00/kg.

## Retail Prices

Despite the slight increase in wholesale prices, the retail price of most of the rice varieties have decreased slightly by less than 2%. Keeri Samba was scarcely available at the retail level, with prices ranging between Rs.350.00 and Rs.380.00, significantly exceeding the maximum retail price (MRP). Additionally, the average retail prices of Samba Grade 1, Nadu Grade 1, and Keeri Samba surpassed the government-regulated MRP. Imported ponne samba was also available in retail markets, with prices ranging from Rs.260.00 to Rs.290.00/kg.

Compared to the same month last year, retail prices for all rice varieties increased by 3-39%, with Keeri Samba showing the highest rise by Rs104.00/kg.

## 2. Other Field Crops

### 2.1 Chilli

#### Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Supply of green chili from major producing areas increased during the month, leading to a notable drop in both wholesale and retail prices by approximately Rs.126.00/kg and Rs.203.00/kg, respectively. The average wholesale and retail prices for green chili were Rs.145.60/kg and Rs.342.14/kg, respectively. In the Embilipitiya area, higher producer prices for green chili were reported, ranging between Rs.100.00 and Rs.228.00/kg in April. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale and retail prices for green chili have fallen by around 51% and 34%, respectively.

In April 2024, a total of 1,068 metric tons (mt) of dried chili was imported, a reduction of 4,767 mt from the previous month. The average CIF price was Rs.560.29/kg, showing a decrease of Rs.74.80/kg from the previous month. Wholesale and retail prices for imported dried chili decreased by approximately Rs.159.00/kg and Rs.67.00/kg, respectively. Prices ranged from Rs.600.00 to Rs.750.00/kg at the wholesale level and Rs.750.00 to Rs.1,200.00/kg at the retail level. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale and retail prices for imported dried chili dropped by about 38% and 22%, respectively.

## 2.2 Big Onion and Red Onion

### Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The market supply of big onions consisted solely of imports this month as well. A total of 11,210 metric tons (mt) of big onions was imported in April 2024, which is 2,400 mt less than the previous month. The average CIF price stood at Rs.218.39/kg, marking a decrease of Rs.28.28/kg from the previous month. The wholesale price of imported big onions dropped by approximately Rs.54.00/kg, while the retail price rose by about Rs.95.00/kg. Average wholesale and retail prices for imported big onions were Rs.404.11/kg and Rs.640.30/kg, respectively, reflecting year-on-year increases of about 342% and 430%.

This month saw a reduced supply of local red onions from main producing areas, leading to price increases for Vedalan onions at both the wholesale and retail levels by roughly Rs.71.00/kg and Rs.26.00/kg, respectively. Limited quantities of Sinnan red onions were available only in wholesale markets, priced between Rs.250.00 and Rs.270.00/kg. During April, 3,635 mt of red onions were

imported from India, a decrease of 3,515 mt from the previous month. The average CIF price for imported red onions was Rs.144.94/kg, up by Rs.9.41/kg compared to the previous month. Consequently, wholesale and retail prices for imported red onions rose by about Rs.34.00/kg and Rs.29.00/kg, respectively. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for Vedalan and imported red onions increased by approximately 12% and 8%, respectively.

## 3. VEGETABLES

### Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Vegetable prices have decreased due to an increased supply from major producing areas. Wholesale prices for up-country vegetables dropped by 16%–60%, with cabbage experiencing the largest decrease at Rs.200.00/kg, ranging from Rs.50.00 to Rs.220.00/kg. Bean prices also fell significantly, down 44%, with prices between Rs.40.00 and Rs.250.00/kg. Other vegetables such as carrot, leeks, beetroot, radish, and knolkhol saw price reductions of 16%–51%.

For low-country vegetables, wholesale prices declined by 7%–50%, with capsicum showing the largest drop of Rs.99.00/kg. Tomato prices fell sharply by 70%, owing to increased supply from producing areas. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices for most vegetables have declined by 5%–48%, with tomato showing the greatest reduction. However, prices for certain vegetables like carrot, beetroot, cabbage, pumpkin, and cucumber have risen by 17%–117%. Meanwhile, green chili prices have decreased by 46%, whereas lime prices have surged by 270%.

In line with the decrease in wholesale prices, retail prices for nearly all vegetable varieties also declined, with the exception of cucumber. Retail prices for up-country vegetables dropped by 11%–42%, with the largest decrease seen in tomato prices, which fell by 52% to Rs.226.00/kg. The highest average price was recorded for drumsticks at Rs.553.00/kg, while radish had the lowest retail price at Rs.182.00/kg. Additionally, green chili prices dropped by 37%, whereas lime prices saw a significant increase of Rs.672/kg. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for most vegetable varieties rose by 1%–88%, with pumpkin experiencing the highest increase.

## 4. Fruits

### Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

In April, the wholesale prices of most of the fruit varieties have increased. Considering the prices of banana varieties, the prices of *kolikuttu* (46%), *ambul* (26%), *seeni* (14%), *anamalu* (13%), and *ambun* (11%) banana have increased. Prices of all the sizes of pineapple have increased in the range of 46%-61% due to availability of limited stocks received from Gampaha district. Monthly average wholesale prices were Rs.1,020.00/fruit (large), Rs.764.00/fruit (medium) and Rs.618.00/fruit (small) sizes of fruits respectively. Considering the mango varieties, the price of *karthakolomban* mango has decreased further by 57% due to arrival of ample stocks from major producing areas and the prices are expected to be decreased further due to on-going harvesting season till June.

Considering the other types of fruit varieties, the highest price increase was recorded for slime apple (46%). Further, the prices of orange and wood apple have increased by 40% and 14% respectively. However, the prices of avocado (42%), papaw (39%) and passion fruit (27%) have decreased due to availability of sufficient stocks.

Compared to the same period of last year, the current wholesale prices of all the fruit varieties have increased with the highest price increase of 81% reported for pineapple (Table 4.1).

In line with wholesale price trends, retail prices for most fruit varieties rose in April. Among banana varieties, the highest price increase was noted for kolikuttu bananas, up by 30%, while prices for other varieties increased by 16%–19%. Retail prices ranged from Rs.350.00 to Rs.700.00/kg for kolikuttu, Rs.150.00 to Rs.350.00/kg for ambul, and Rs.150.00 to Rs.300.00/kg for seeni bananas in Colombo and surrounding areas.

For pineapples, retail prices increased by 40%–54% due to rising wholesale costs, with prices ranging from Rs.450.00 to Rs.1,360.00 per fruit in Colombo suburbs.

Among other fruits, avocado showed the largest retail price increase at 40%, followed by wood apple at 16% and orange at 12%. In contrast, prices for passion fruit and papaw decreased by 21% and 13%, respectively, due to lower wholesale prices. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for most fruit varieties have risen, with the highest increase of 90% reported for passion fruit.

### Exports/Imports of Fruits

According to Sri Lanka Customs, Sri Lanka exported 1,113 metric tons (mt) of fresh fruits in April 2024, valued at Rs.144 million. Papaw accounted for 96% of the exports, while fresh pineapple made up 3%. Compared to April 2023, when 807 mt were exported, the quantity has increased this year (Table 4.3).

Regarding imports, Sri Lanka imported 1,128 mt of fresh fruits in April, valued at Rs.563 million. Apples were the most imported fruit, totaling 583 mt, followed by grapes at 442 mt. Compared to April 2023, when 700 mt were imported, the import quantity also rose this year (Table 4.4).

Headline inflation, measured by the year-on-year (Y-o-Y) change in the Colombo Consumer Price Index (CCPI, 2021=100), rose to 1.5% in April 2024, up from 0.9% in March 2024. Food inflation (Y-o-Y) eased slightly to 2.9% in April from 3.8% in March.

Despite the slight decline in inflation, wholesale prices for most fish varieties increased in April due to high demand during the Sinhala and Tamil New Year season. However, favorable fishing weather along the southern and eastern coasts led to higher fish supplies during the month.

Wholesale prices for all fish varieties rose in April, with the largest increase reported for salaya at 33%, followed by mora at 32% and balaya at 28%. Prices of other varieties increased between 3% and 19%. Despite the high supply of deep-sea fish from all fishing districts due to favorable weather, demand remained strong, driving prices upward. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices for most fresh fish varieties increased by 3% to 32%, with the highest rise seen in small shrimps.

Retail fish prices followed a similar trend, with prices for all varieties increasing. Salaya saw the highest retail price rise at 34%, followed by balaya and small shrimps at 13% and 10%, respectively. Prices for other varieties increased by 1% to 9%. Compared to the same period last year, retail

prices for most fresh fish varieties were higher, with small shrimps showing the largest increase at 30%.

## Dried Fish

### Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Despite the rise in fresh fish prices, wholesale prices for most dried fish varieties dropped in April 2024 due to low demand during the New Year festival season. The largest price decrease was recorded for salaya, with a drop of 16%. Prices for both imported sprats and balaya also fell by 6%. Other dried fish varieties, excluding mora, saw price drops of less than 2%. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices for most dried fish varieties have decreased, with the highest drop recorded for salaya at 39%.

At the retail level, prices for all dried fish varieties, except salaya, also declined. The biggest price decrease at retail was for balaya, which fell by 8%, followed by a 5% drop for sprats and a 3% decrease for anguluwa. Prices for other dried fish varieties, except salaya, decreased slightly by less than 3%. However, the price of salaya increased by 11% in April. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for most dried fish varieties rose, with the highest increase noted for sprats at 8%.

With the increase in local egg production, driven by the resumed importation of day-old chicks, poultry feeds, and veterinary medicines, egg prices continued to decline in April. Additionally, egg producers expanded their operations in anticipation of the New Year festival season, resulting in higher egg supplies during the month. Meanwhile, the availability of imported eggs remained low in the market. These factors led to a decrease in the prices of both brown and white eggs at the wholesale market, with brown eggs dropping by 7% and white eggs by 8%.

In line with the decrease in wholesale prices, retail prices for both brown and white eggs also fell by 6%. The average retail prices for brown and white eggs decreased to Rs.50.40 and Rs.47.73, respectively, in April. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for both types of eggs declined by 5% for brown eggs and 9% for white eggs.

Compared to March, prices for most meat varieties saw a slight increase at the retail market during the New Year festival season. The highest price increases were observed for beef (without bones) and pork, both rising by 3% in April. Chicken (broiler) also experienced a price increase of 2% during the month. However, the price of chicken (curry) dropped by 6%. When compared to the



same period last year, prices for most meat varieties decreased, with the largest decrease recorded for pork, which dropped by 22%.
